## The Wind Phone

One hope of that garden plan is to install a Wind Phone, it would be the only one in Minnesota. ## What is a Wind Phone?

Simply put, it is a disconnected phone which mourners can use to call their loved one who has died. The concept began in Japan 15 years ago, and now one can find Wind Phones all over the world. People have reported that the experience of these conversations with loved ones provides comfort and allows them to grieve in ways they find helpful. It fits well with what research has named Continuing Bonds theory.
